- 1) Patients having low T3 and T4 levels but high TSH levels suffer from primary hypothyroidism, cretinism, juvenile myxedema or autoimmune disorders.
- 2) Patients having high T3 and T4 levels but low TSH levels suffer from Grave's disease, toxic adenoma or sub-acute thyroiditis.
- 3) Patients having either low or normal T3 and T4 levels but low TSH values suffer from iodine deficiency or secondary hypothyroidism.
- **4)** Patients having high T3 and T4 levels but normal TSH levels may suffer from toxic multinodular goiter. This condition is mostly a symptomatic and may cause transient hyperthyroidism but no persistent symptoms.
- **5**) Patients with high or normal T3 and T4 levels and low or normal TSH levels suffer either from T3 toxicosis or T4 toxicosis respectively.
- **6)** In patients with non thyroidal illness abnormal test results are not necessarily indicative of thyroidism but may be due to adaptation to the catabolic state and may revert to normal when the patient recovers.
- 7) There are many drugs for eg. Glucocorticoids, Dopamine, Lithium, Iodides, Oral radiographic dyes, etc. which may affect the thyroid function tests.
- **8)** Generally when total T3 and total T4 results are indecisive then Free T3 and Free T4 tests are recommended for further confirmation along with TSH levels.

# ULTRASOUND WHOLE ABDOMEN (UPPER & LOWER) \*

**LIVER**: - Normal in size (12.9 cm), shape and echogenicity. No focal lesion is seen. No intra hepatic biliary radicle dilation seen.

**GALL BLADDER**: Well distended, walls are normal. No e/o calculus / focal mass lesion/ pericholecystic fluid.

**CBD**:- Normal in calibre at porta.

**PORTAL VEIN**: - Normal in calibre and colour uptake at porta.

**PANCREAS:** - Head is visualised, normal in size & echopattern. No e/o ductal dilatation or calcification. Rest of pancreas is obscured by bowel gas.

**SPLEEN**: - Normal in size, shape and echogenicity.

**RIGHT KIDNEY**: - Normal in size (8.6 cm), shape and echogenicity. No focal lesion or calculus seen. Pelvicalyceal system is not dilated.

**LEFT KIDNEY**: - Normal in size (9.3 cm), shape and echogenicity. No focal lesion or calculus seen. Pelvicalyceal system is not dilated.

**URINARY BLADDER:** Normal in shape, outline and distension. No e/o wall thickening / calculus.

**UTERUS**:- Anteverted, and is **bulkyin size** (8.7 x 4.4 x 5.2 cm vol - 105.5 cc). No focal myometrial lesion seen. Endometrium is normal in thickness 6.8 mm.

**OVARIES**: Bilateral ovaries are normal in size, shape and echogenicity.

**ADNEXA:** No obvious adnexal pathology

Visualized bowel loops are normal in caliber. No para-aortic lymphadenopathy

No free fluid is seen in the abdomen/pelvis.

**IMPRESSION**: Bulky uterus.
