USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

LIVER: Liver appears mildly enlarged in size(18.0 cm) and shows normal homogeneous echoreflectivity. There is no intra-hepatic biliary radical dilatation. No evidence of any focal lesion.

GALL BLADDER: Gall bladder is contracted.(Not evaluated)

PORTAL VEIN: Portal vein is normal. **CBD:** CBD is normal.

PANCREAS: Visualised head of pancreas appears normal in size & echotexture. Rest is obscured by excessive bowel gas.

KIDNEYS: Right kidney measures 10.4 x 3.5 cm. Left kidney measures 10.6 x 4.5 cm. Both kidneys are normal in size, shape and echotexture. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. There is no evidence of any hydronephrosis, hydroureter or calculus.

SPLEEN: Spleen is normal in size, shape and echotexture. No focal lesion is seen.

URINARY BLADDER: Urinary bladder is distended and normal. Wall thickness is within normal limits.

UTERUS: Uterus is anteverted and measures 8.5 x 4.2 x 4.5 cm. Uterine myometrium shows homogenous echotexture. Endometrial echo is in midline and measures 8.0 mm. Cervix appears normal.

OVARIES: Both ovaries are normal. Bilateral adnexa are clear.

No free fluid or significant lymphadenopathy is seen.

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IMPRESSION:

- **MILD HEPATOMEGALY.**

Note: Investigations have their limitations. Solitary radiological investigations never confirm the final diagnosis. They only help in diagnosing the disease in correlation to clinical symptoms and other related tests. USG is known to have inter-observer variations. Further/follow-up imaging may be needed in some cases for confirmation / exclusion of diagnosis.

Advice: Clinical co-relation and further evaluation.
