ABDOMINO-PELVIC ULTRASONOGRAPHY

LIVER is normal in shape, size (11.5 cm) and has uniform echopattern. No evidence of focal lesion or intrahepatic biliary ductal dilatation. Hepatic and portal vein radicals are normal.

GALL BLADDER is partially distended.

CBD is not dilated.

PANCREAS has normal shape, size and uniform echopattern. No evidence of ductal dilatation or calcification.

SPLEEN show normal shape, size and echopattern.

No demonstrable Para-aortic lymphadenopathy.

KIDNEYS

Right kidney: Normal in shape, size and echopattern. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well madeout. Tiny echogenic focus measuring 4.3 mm upper pole of the right kidney. No evidence of calculus or hydronephrosis.

Left kidney: Normal in shape, size and echopattern. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well madeout. . There is a calculus measuring 5 mm in the mid calyx. No evidence of hydronephrosis.

The kidney measures as follows:

-	Bipolar length (cm)	Parenchymal thickness (cm)
Right Kidney	10.5	1.8
Left Kidney	10.4	1.9

URINARY BLADDER show normal shape and wall thickness. It has clear contents. No evidence of diverticula.

UTERUS is retroverted and bulky.

Endometrial echo is of normal thickness - 9.3 mm. Uterus measures LS: 7.8 cm AP: 4.8 cm TS: 6.1 cm.

OVARIES are normal in size, shape and echotexture Right ovary measures Left ovary measures

Minimal free fluid is noted in the POD.

A dilated tubular structure measuring 7.2 mm in maximum diameter is noted in the right adnexa. No internal echoes.
