STOOL FOR OCCULT BLOOD			
Occult Blood	Stool	Negative	Standard Guaiac Method
NOTE		Interpretation :	

1. The test for Occult blood in Stool is useful in the detection of bleeding caused by gastrointestinal disorders such as colitis, polyps, diverticulitis, colorectal cancer and hookworm infestation.

2. Stool samples collected during menstrual bleeding, constipation induced bleeding, bleeding hemorrhoids or when rectal medication is used may cause false-positive results.

3. Vitamin C when taken in amounts greater than 250 mg per day has been shown to induce false-negative results. Rectal medications (suppositories) and iron-containing medication may also interfere with these tests. Raw meat, Raw broccoli, cauliflower, radishes and turnips may cause a false positive result, hence should be avoided.

Specimen

USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

LIVER is normal in size shape and echotexture.
No evidence of any focal lesion seen.
Intrahepatic billiary radicals are not dilated.
PORTAL VEIN and CBD are normal in course and caliber.

GALL BLADDER is physiologically distended. No stones or sludge seen within it.
Wall thickness is within normal limits.

PANCREAS is normal in shape size and echotexture.

SPLEEN is normal in size shape and echotexture.
No focal lesion seen.

Both KIDNEYS are normal in shape size and echotexture.
No evidence of calculus or hydronephrosis seen.
URETERS are not dilated.

BLADDER is partially distended. No calculus or mass lesion seen.

Prostate is normal in size shape and echotexture.

There is no free fluid or abdominal lymphadenopathy seen.

IMPRESSION:
No significant visceral abnormality seen.
Suggest clinical correlation / further evaluation.
