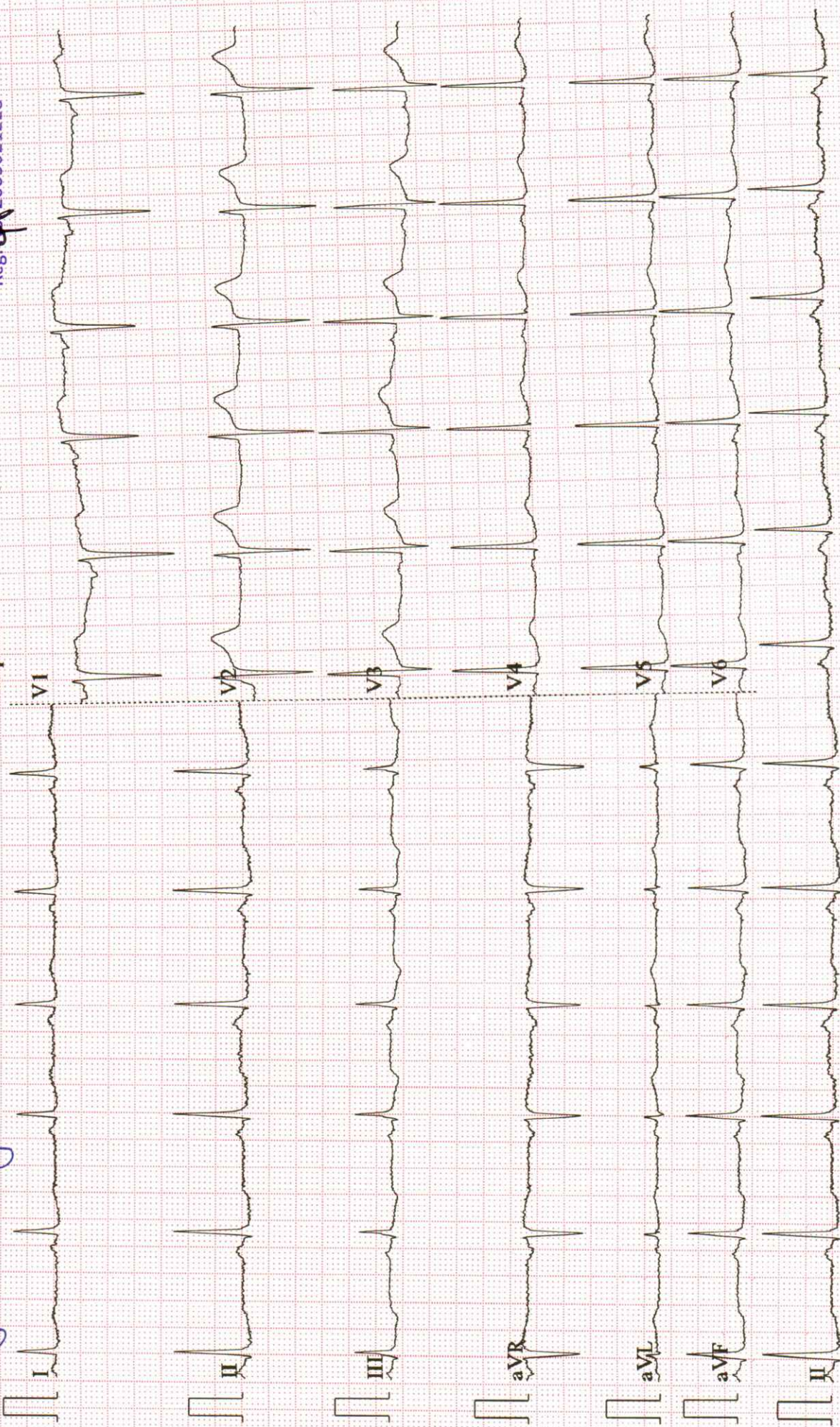

USG ABDOMEN & PELVIS

FINDINGS: -

The **liver** dimension is normal in size. It appears normal in morphology with normal echogenicity. No evidence of intrahepatic ductal dilatation.

The **GB**-gallbladder is distended normally. Wall thickness is normal.

The **CBD**- common bile duct is normal. The portal vein is 8.9 mm normal.

The **pancreas** appears normal in morphology.

The **spleen** is mildly enlarged in size (12.3 cm) and morphology.

Both **kidneys** demonstrate normal morphology.

Both kidneys show normal cortical echogenicity.

The right kidney measures 10.5 x 4.4 cm.

The left kidney measures 10.0 x 4.0 cm.

Urinary bladder: -normally distended. Wall thickness - normal.

Prostate is normal in size and morphology Size: 24 gms

Seminal vesicles appear normal.

No **free fluid** is seen.



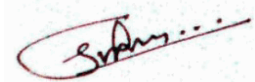

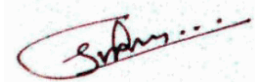
INTERPRETATION :

TSH stimulates the production and secretion of the metabolically active thyroid hormones, thyroxine (T4) and triiodothyronine (T3), by interacting with a specific receptor on the thyroid cell surface. The synthesis and secretion of TSH is stimulated by Thyrotropin releasing hormone (TRH), in response to low levels of circulating thyroid hormones. Elevated levels of T3 and T4 suppress the production of TSH via a classic negative feedback mechanism. Failure at any level of regulation of the hypothalamic-pituitary-thyroid axis will result in either underproduction (hypothyroidism) or overproduction (hyperthyroidism) of T4 and/or T3.



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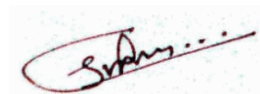

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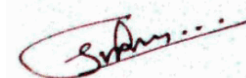

2. Don't take insulin or oral hypoglycemic agent until after fasting blood sample has been drawn

- Plasma glucose >=200 mg/dl (2 hrs after 75 grams of glucose)
- Glycosylated haemoglobin > 6.5%


