Immature Granulocyte (IG) count is a useful early marker of infection or inflammation, even when other markers are normal. It is an early and rapid discrimination of bacterial from viral infections. It is also increased in patients on steroid therapy / chemotherapy or haematological malignancy. High IG is always pathological; except in pregnancy and neonates of < 7 days.
Method : HB by Non-Cyanide Hemoglobin analysis method. HCT by RBC pulse height detection method. RBC, TLC & PLC are by Particle Count by Electrical Impedance in Cell Counter. 

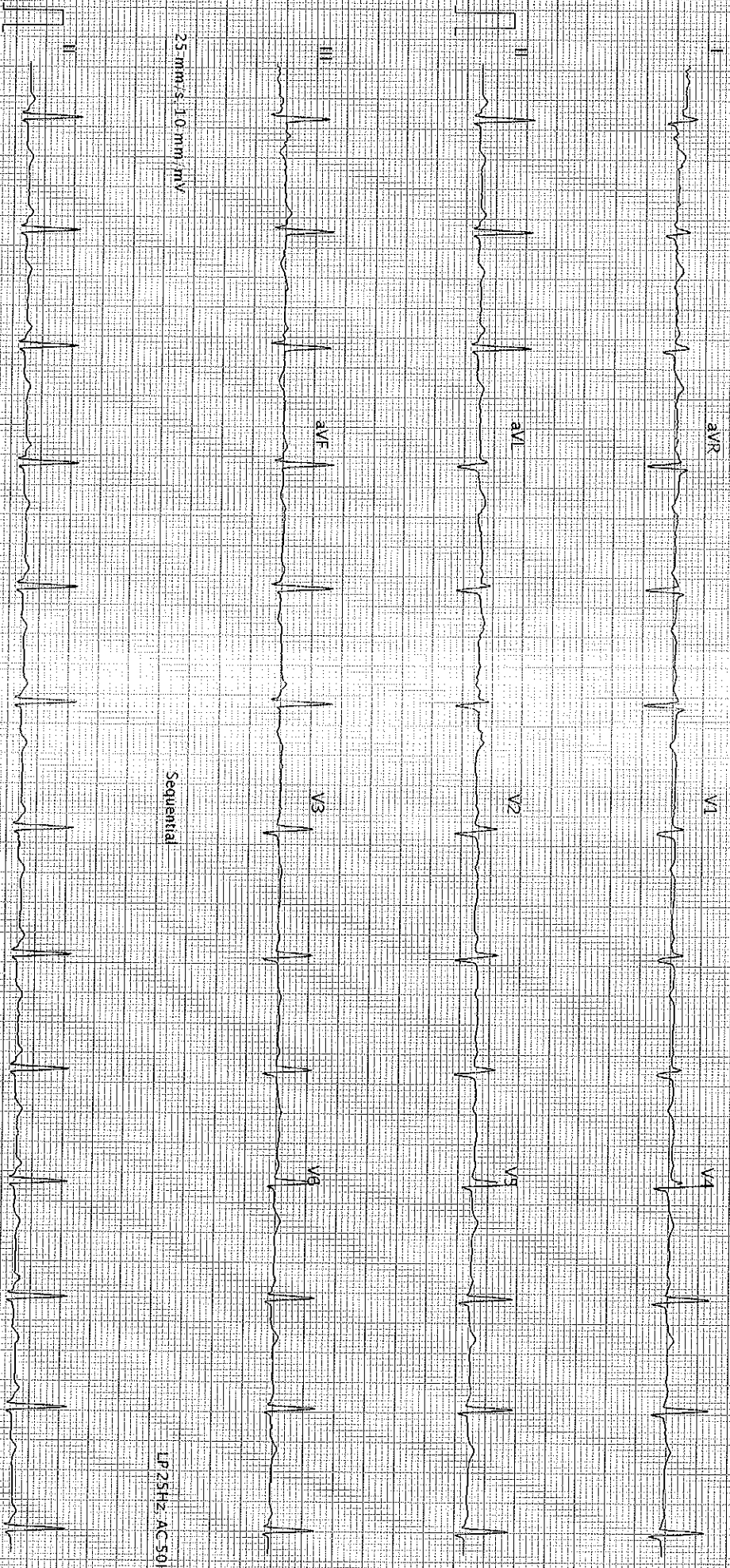
