BILATERAL SONOMAMMOGRAPHY

Both the breasts show diffuse fibrocystic changes.

A small (7 x 4mm) well-defined, hypoechoic lesion is noted in the 2 O' clock position (about 2-3cms away from the nipple) in the right breast. Color doppler shows no increase in the vascularity of the lesion. Features suggest fibroadenoma.

Multiple small (2-7mm) cysts are noted in both the breasts, few of them showing internal echoes.

Right breast:

- **10-11 O'clock position (about 2.0cms away from the nipple) - 5 x 6mm, 4mm**
- **11-12 O'clock position (periareolar) - 7 x 7mm**
- **1-2 O'clock position (periareolar) - 3mm**

Left breast:

- **11 O'clock position (periareolar) - 3mm, 5mm, 6mm**
- **11-12 O'clock position (periareolar) - 2mm, 3mm, 3mm**
- **2-3 O'clock position (about 3-4cms away from the nipple) - 6mm**
- **6-7 O'clock position (periareolar) - 3mm, 6mm**

Retroareolar region is normal on either side.

Few lymphnodes with maintained fatty hilum are noted in both axillae.

IMPRESSION:

- **BILATERAL FIBROCYSTIC CHANGES WITH SMALL SCATTERED CYSTS IN BOTH THE BREASTS AS DESCRIBED.**
- **SMALL (7 x 4mm) WELL-DEFINED HYPOECHOIC LESION IN THE 2 O' CLOCK POSITION IN THE RIGHT BREAST SUGGESTS FIBROADENOMA.**

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
