USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

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LIVER: Liver appears normal in size and echotexture. There is no intra-hepatic biliary radical dilatation. No evidence of any focal lesion.

GALL BLADDER: Gall bladder is contracted.(Not evaluated)

PORTAL VEIN: Portal vein is normal. **CBD:** CBD is normal.

PANCREAS: Visualised head and body of pancreas appears normal in size & echotexture. Rest is obscured by excessive bowel gas.

KIDNEYS: Right kidney measures 9.3 x 3.7 cm. Left kidney measures 9.4 x 4.8 cm.

There is evidence of proximal hydroureter bilaterally ,mid-distal ureter could not be traced due to excessive bowel gas.

Both kidneys are normal in shape and echotexture. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained.

SPLEEN: Spleen is normal in size, shape and echotexture. No focal lesion is seen.

<u>URINARY BLADDER:</u> Urinary bladder is distended and normal. Wall thickness is within normal limits. Prevoid volume is 177 cc Postvoid volume is 08 cc (Not significant)

PROSTATE: Prostate is normal in size and echotexture and measures 3.1 x 3.3 x 3.9 cm in dimension and 21.2 cc in volume. No evidence of any focal lesion. Median lobe does not show significant hypertrophy.

No free fluid or significant lymphadenopathy is seen.

Bowel gas++++

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IMPRESSION:

BILATERAL RENAL PROXIMAL HYDROURETER. Needs further evaluation.

Note:Investigations have their limitations. Solitary radiological investigations never confirm the final diagnosis. They only help in diagnosing the disease in correlation to clinical symptoms and other related tests. USG is known to have interobserver variations. Further/follow-up imaging may be needed in some cases for confirmation / exclusion of diagnosis.

Advice: Clinical co-relation and further evaluation.
