### ABDOMINO-PELVIC ULTRASONOGRAPHY

**LIVER** is normal in shape, size (13.2 cms) and has uniform echopattern. No evidence of focal lesion or intrahepatic biliary ductal dilatation. Hepatic and portal vein radicals are normal.

**GALL BLADDER** is partially distended. CBD is not dilated.

**PANCREAS** has normal shape, size and uniform echopattern. No evidence of ductal dilatation or calcification.

**SPLEEN** show normal shape, size (9.5 cms) and echopattern.

No demonstrable Para-aortic lymphadenopathy.

#### **KIDNEYS**

**Right kidney:** Normal in shape, size and echopattern. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well madeout. No evidence of calculus or hydronephrosis.

**Left kidney:** Normal in shape, size and echopattern. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well madeout. No evidence of calculus or hydronephrosis.

The kidney measures as follows:

**URINARY BLADDER** show normal shape and wall thickness. It has clear contents. No evidence of diverticula.

(TVS)

**UTERUS** is anteverted and has normal shape and size. It has uniform myometrial echopattern. IUCD in situ.

Uterus measures LS: 5.5 cm AP: 4.2 cm TS: 4.6 cm.

Nabothian cysts are seen in cervix.

**OVARIES** are shows multiple subcentimeter peripherally arranged follicles.

Right ovary measures 3.1 x 1.9 x 2.3 cms (Volume: 7.3cc).

Left ovary measures 3.3 x 2.3 x 2.3 cms (Volume: 9.3 cc).

POD & adnexa are free. No evidence of ascites.

#### **IMPRESSION:**

- **Bilateral ovaries show peripherally arranged subcentimeter follicles - ?**

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1.This is only a radiological impression.Like other investigations, radiological investigation also have limitation. Therefore radiological reports should be interpreted in correlation with clinical and pathological findings.

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**Polycystic ovaries.**

- **No other significant abnormality detected.**
