Immature Granulocyte (IG) count is a useful early marker of infection or inflammation, even when other markers are normal. It is an early and rapid discrimination of bacterial from viral infections. It is also increased in patients on steroid therapy / chemotherapy or haematological malignancy. High IG is always pathological; except in pregnancy and neonates of < 7 days.  
Method : HB by Non-Cyanide Hemoglobin analysis method. HCT by RBC pulse height detection method. RBC, TLC & PLC are by Particle Count by Electrical Impedance in Cell Counter. Optical Platelets by Fluorescent + Laser Technology. MCV, MCH, MCHC, RDW (CV & SD) are calculated parameter. DLC by Flowcytometry method using semi-conductor Laser + Smear verification. ESR on Ves metic 20, comparable to Westergrens method and in accordance to ICSH reference method.

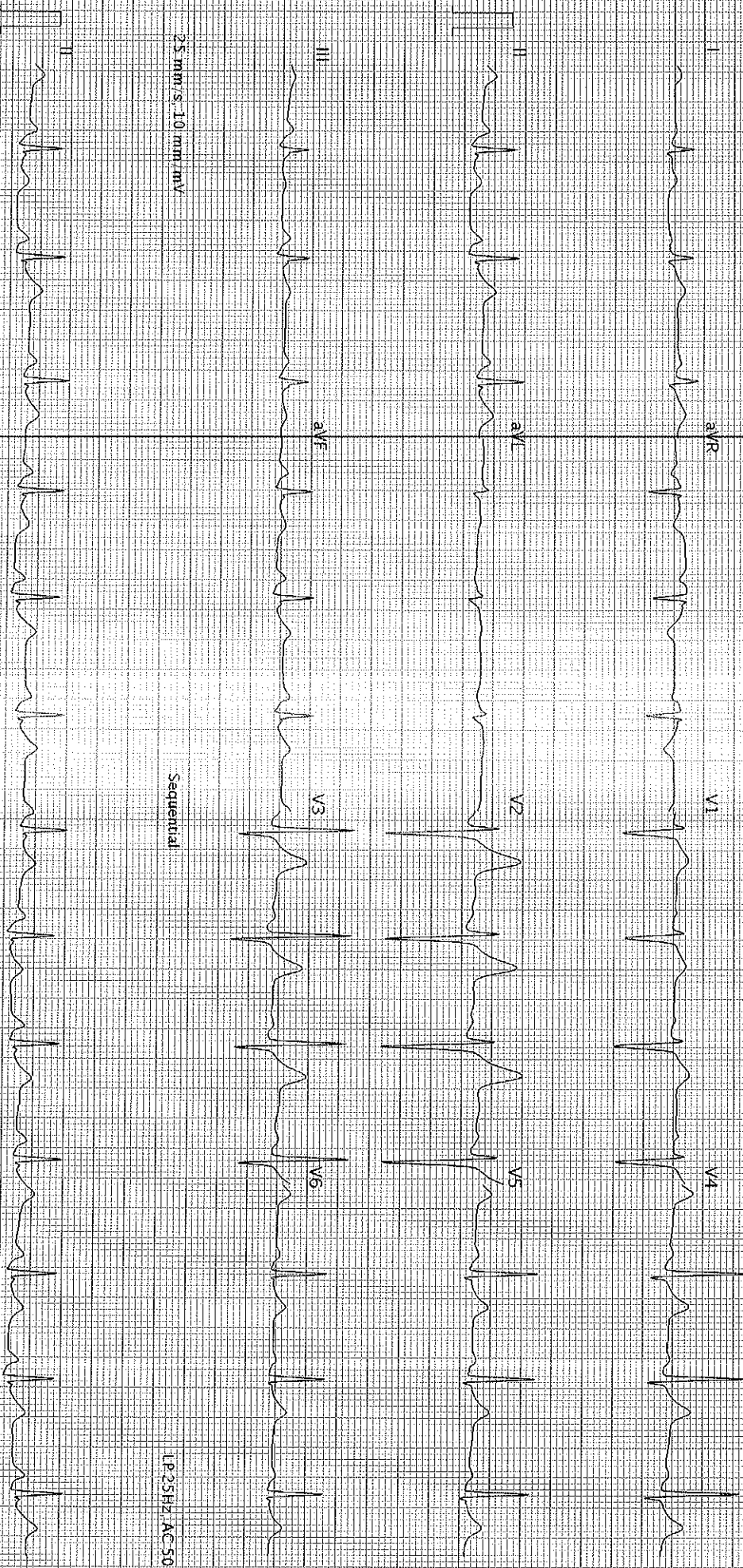
