Interpretation:

1. HbA1C above 6.5% can be used to diagnose diabetes provided the patient has symptoms. If the patient does not have symptoms with HbA1C>6.5%, repeat measurement on further sample. If the repeat test result is <6.5%, consider as diabetes high risk and repeat measurement after 6 months.
2. HbA1C measurement is not appropriate in diagnosing diabetes in children, suspicion of type 1 diabetes, symptoms of diabetes for less than 2 months, pregnancy, hemoglobinopathies, medications that may result sudden increase in glucose, anemia, renal failure, HIV infection, malignancies, severe chronic hepatic, and renal disease.
3. Any sample with >15% should be suspected of having a haemoglobin variant.



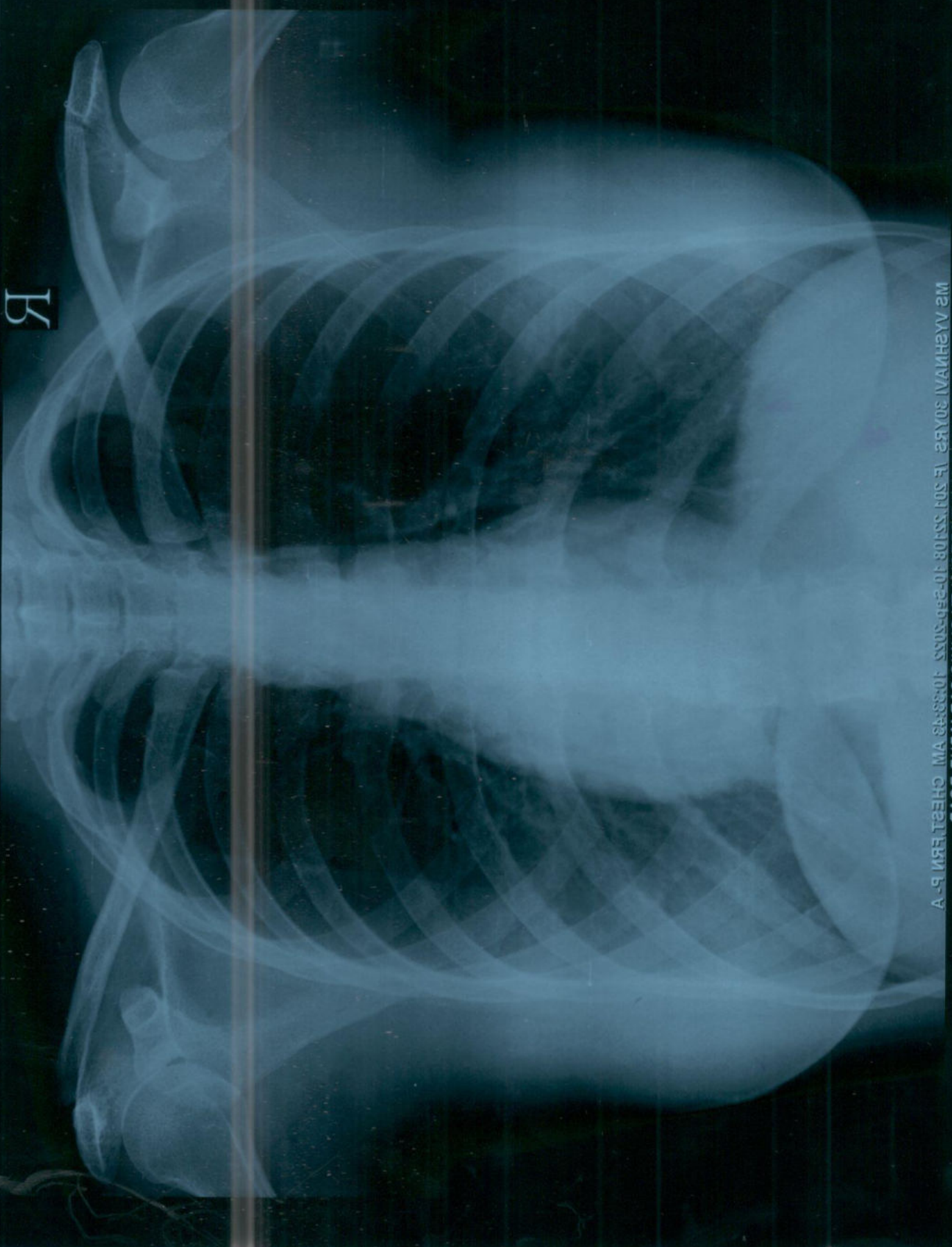

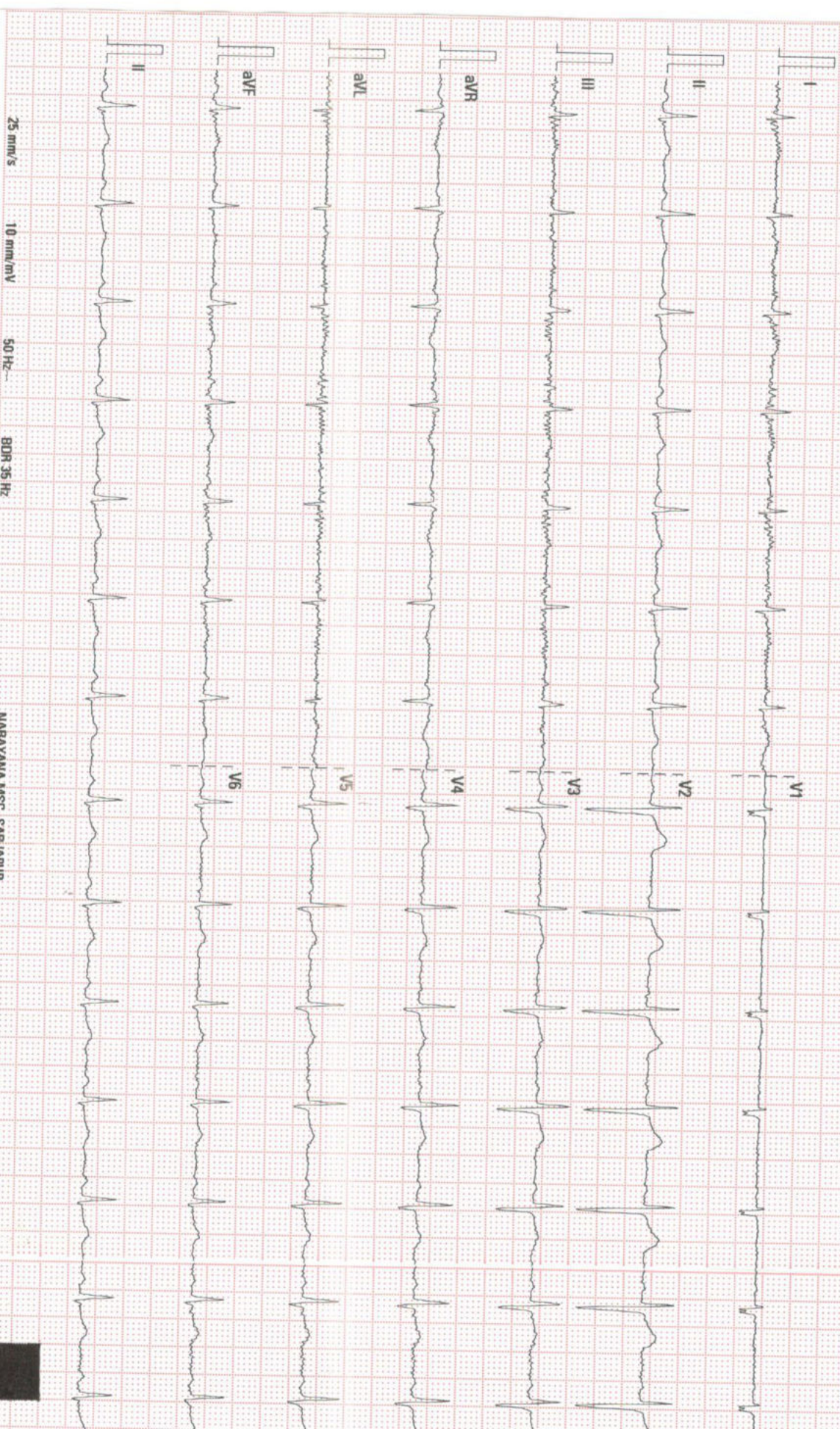

ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN

FINDINGS:

Liver is normal in size (13cm) and echopattern. No intra or extra hepatic biliary duct dilatation. No focal lesions.

Portal vein is normal in size, course and caliber. **CBD** is not dilated.

Gall bladder is normal without evidence of calculi, wall thickening or pericholecystic fluid.

Pancreas to the extent visualized, appears normal in size, contour and echogenicity

Spleen is normal in size (9.9cm), shape, contour and echopattern. No evidence of mass or focal lesions.

Right Kidney is normal in size (measures 9.4 cm in length & 0.8 cm in parenchymal thickness), position, shape and echopattern. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. No evidence of calculi or hydronephrosis.

Left Kidney is normal in size (measures 9.9 cm in length & 1.4cm in parenchymal thickness), position, shape and echopattern. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. No evidence of calculi or hydronephrosis.

Retroperitoneum – Obscured by bowel gas.

There is no ascites or pleural effusion.
