Liver is normal in size and outline. It shows diffuse fatty infiltration. No focal lesion is seen. Intrahepatic vascular and biliary radicles are normal

Gallbladder is contracted. (Patient is not fasting). The common bile duct is not dilated. No calculus is seen in CBD lumen.

Pancreatic size, outline and echogenicity are normal. Peripancreatic planes are well defined. No calcification or ductal dilatation seen.

Both kidneys are normal in size and position. Cortical outline, echogenicity and corticomedullary differentiation are normal. No e/o any calculus or hydronephrosis seen.

No e/o Abdominal lymphadenopathy / Ascites seen.

Spleen is normal in size .No focal lesions are seen. Splenic vein appears normal

Urinary bladder is empty.

Uterus is gravid & contain single intrauterine live fetus.
