Organ: ABDOMEN

Liver is normal in size and outline. It shows diffuse fatty infiltration. No focal lesion is seen. Intrahepatic vascular and biliary radicles are normal.

Gallbladder is partially distended. Visualized lumen is clear. It shows normal wall thickness. The common bile duct is not dilated. No calculus is seen in CBD lumen.

Pancreatic size, outline and echogenicity are normal. Peripancreatic planes are well defined. No calcification or ductal dilatation seen.

Spleen is enlarged in size measures 12.8cm. No focal lesions are seen. Splenic vein appears normal

Both kidneys are normal in size and position. Cortical outline, echogenicity and corticomedullary differentiation are normal. *2-3 concretions are noted in each kidney.* No e/o any hydronephrosis seen.

No e/o Abdominal lymphadenopathy / Ascites seen.

Urinary bladder is optimally distended with normal wall thickness. Few echoes are noted in its lumen (**advise urine complete examination).** No e/o any calculus or mass seen.

Prostate is normal in size. Parenchymal echogenicity is normal. No focal lesion is seen. Seminal vesicles are normal.

IMPRESSION:

- DIFFUSE FATTY INFILTRATION OF LIVER (GRADE I)
- SPLENOMEGALY
