RADIOLOGY

USG REPORT - ABDOMEN AND PELVIS

OBSERVATION:

LIVER:

Liver is mildly enlarged in size (16.9 cm) and shows mild diffuse increase in echotexture. No focal lesion is seen. Intrahepatic biliary radicles not dilated. Hepatic and portal veins are normal. CBD is normal.

GALL BLADDER:

Normal in distension. Lumen echo free, Wall thickness is normal.

PANCREAS:

Head and body visualized appears normal. No focal lesion is seen. Pancreatic duct not dilated. Tail not visualized.

SPLEEN:

Normal in size (10.3 cm) with homogenous echotexture. No focal lesion seen.

RIGHT KIDNEY:

Right kidney measures 11.5×1.4 cm (length x parenchymal thickness) with normal echo pattern and cortical thickness.

The shape, size and contour of the right kidney appear normal.

Cortical medullary differentiation is maintained.

No evidence of pelvicalyceal dilatation. No sonologically detectable calculi seen.

LEFT KIDNEY:

Left kidney measures $10.7 \times 1.6 \text{ cm}$ (length x parenchymal thickness) with normal echo pattern and cortical thickness.

The shape, size and contour of the left kidney appear normal.

Cortical medullary differentiation is maintained.

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No evidence of pelvicalyceal dilatation. No sonologically detectable calculi seen.

URINARY BLADDER:

Is normal in contour. No intraluminal echoes are seen. No calculus or diverticulum is seen. Wall thickness appears normal.

PROSTATE:

Is normal in size (17.4 cc) with normal echo pattern. **Prostatic parenchymal** calcification seen.

No evidence of free fluid in the pelvic or abdominal cavity.
