 - Avoid all sources of extra salt, spices and oils like sauces, pickles, papads, chutneys, chips, etc.
 - Avoid all sources of simple sugars like white sugar, brown sugar, honey, jaggery.
 - Avoid carbonated and caffeinated beverages.
 - Restrict bakery products and other products that have soda.
 - Avoid processed foods, fried food, oily, oily and refined flour products
 - Increase Iron Sources Such As Dates, Raisin, Pomegranate, Amaranth Leaves, Fenugreek, Rajgira.
 - Have 1-400 Tsp Of Haldi/ Seeds (Soaked Overnight) + Asha Leaven Drops.







INTERPRETATION

- HbA1c is used for monitoring diabetic control. It reflects the estimated average glucose (eAG).
- HbA1c has been endorsed by clinical groups & ADA (American Diabetes Association) guidelines 2017, for diagnosis of diabetes using a cut-off point of 6.5%.
- Trends in HbA1c are a better indicator of diabetic control than a solitary test.
- Low glycosylated haemoglobin (below 4%) in a non-diabetic individual are often associated with systemic inflammatory diseases, chronic anaemia (especially severe iron deficiency & haemolytic), chronic renal failure and liver diseases. Clinical correlation suggested.
- To estimate the eAG from the HbA1c value, the following equation is used: eAG(mg/dl) = 28.7 * A1c - 46.7
- Interference of Haemoglobinopathies in HbA1c estimation.
 - For HbF > 25% an alternate platform (Fructosamine) is recommended for testing of HbA1c.
 - Homozygous hemoglobinopathy is detected, fructosamine is recommended for monitoring diabetic status
 - Heterozygous state detected (D10/Tosho G8 is corrected for HbS and HbC trait).
- In known diabetic patients, following values can be considered as a tool for monitoring the glycaemic control.
 - Excellent Control - 6 to 7 %
 - Fair to Good Control - 7 to 8 %
 - Unsatisfactory Control - 8 to 10 %
 - and Poor Control - More than 10 %.

Note : Haemoglobin a electrophoresis (HPLC method) is recommended for detecting hemoglobinopathy

Prostate-specific antigen (PSA) is a glycoprotein that is produced by the prostate gland, the lining of the urethra, and the bulbourethral gland. PSA exists in serum mainly in two forms, complexed to alpha-1-antitrypsin (PSA-ACT complex) and unbound (free PSA). Increases in prostatic glandular size and tissue damage caused by benign prostatic hyperplasia, prostatitis, or prostate cancer may increase circulating PSA levels. Transient increase in PSA can also be seen following per rectal digital or sonological examinations.
