Clinical Details: HC

Observation:

- Both the lung fields appears normal.
- Both costophrenic angles appear clear.
- Both the hila appears normal.
- Trachea appears in midline.
- Cardiac size and other mediastinal shadows appears normal.
- Both domes of diaphragm appear normal.
- Bony thorax appears normal.

Findings:

Liver is normal in size, shape and shows normal echopattern. No e/o any focal or diffuse lesion noted. Intrahepatic biliary radicals are normal.

Gall bladder is distended and appears normal. No e/o calculus, sludge or mass lesion is seen. CBD and Portal Vein appears normal in size and calibre.

Pancreas appears normal in size and shows normal echopattern to the extent assessed. Spleen appears normal in size, shape and homogenous echopattern.

Both kidneys appear normal in size, shape and echopattern. The corticomedullary differentiation is well maintained. No e/o hydronephrosis on right side.

Right kidney : A non obstructing calculus measuring ~ 3 mm noted in lower pole calyx. Moderate hydronephrosis noted with dilated left ureter. A calculus measuring ~ 6.4 mm noted in lower ureter ~ 4 cm away from left VUJ.

Aorta and para-aortic regions appears normal. No e/o any lymphadenopathy. Urinary bladder appears well distended and normal. No e/o free fluid in abdomen.

IMPRESSION:

- A lower left ureteric calculus (~ 6.4 mm), ~ 4 cm away from left VUJ causes moderate left hydroureteronephrosis.
- Bilateral non obstructing renal calculi.
