Importance of HbA1c - Glycated Hb. in Diabetes Mellitus

 HbA1c, also known as Glycated Hemoglobin is the most important test for the assessment of long term blood glucose control (also called glycemic control)

 HbA1c reflects mean blood glucose concentration over past 6-8 weeks and provides amuch better indication of long term glycemic control than blood glucose determination

• HbA1c is formed by non-enzymatic reaction between glucose and Hb., this reaction is irreversible and therefore remains unaffected by short term fluctuations in blood glucose levels.

• Long term complications of diabetes such as retinopathy-eye complications, nephropathy-kidney complications and neuropathy-nerve complications, are potentially serious and can lead to blindness, kidney failure etc.

• Glycemic control monitored by HbA1c measurement using HPLC method-(Gold Standard) is considered most important. (Ref. National Glycohemoglobin Standardization Program - NGSP).
