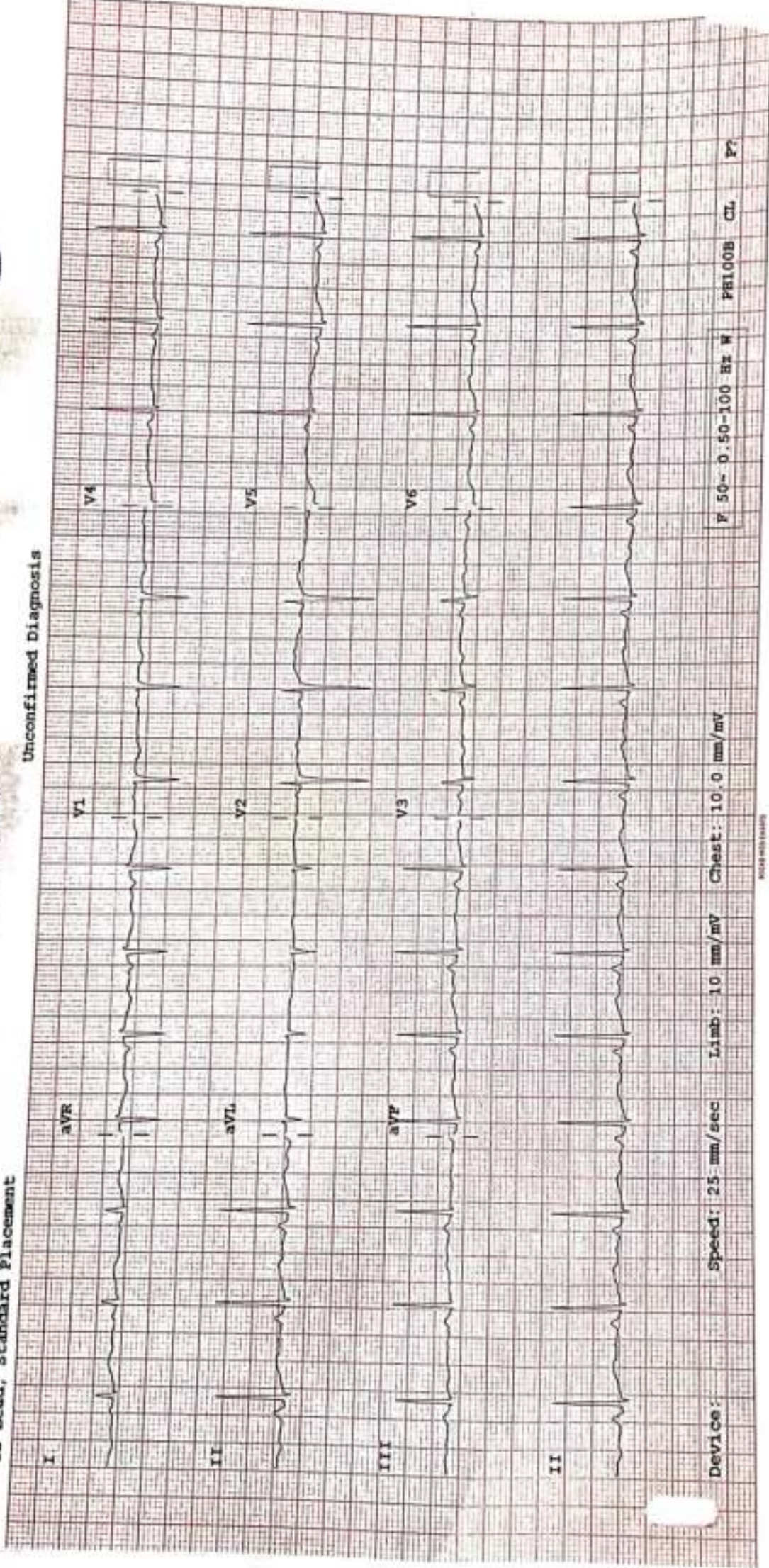

USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

- LIVER** : Liver is normal in size, shape & echotexture. No obvious focal lesion is seen. IHBR are not dilated.
- GALL BLADDER** : GB is well distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen. The wall thickness is normal.
- CBD** : CBD is normal in course & caliber.
- PV** : PV is normal in course & caliber.
- PANCREAS** : Pancreas is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Peripancreatic soft tissues appear normal. MPD is not dilated.
- SPLEEN** : Spleen is normal in shape, size & echotexture. It measures 9.1cm in size.
- KIDNEYS** : The right kidney measures 9.3 x 3cm. The left kidney measures 9.7 x 4.7cm. Both kidneys are normal in shape, size & position. The pelvicalyceal system is normal. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. No focal lesion is seen.
- URINARY BLADDER** : Urinary bladder is well distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen. The wall thickness is normal.
- UTERUS** : Uterus is normal in size, shape & echotexture. It measures 7.2 x 3.5 x 4.2cm. Endometrium is central and measures 7.6 mm.
- OVARIES** : The right ovary measures 2.9 x 1.3cm. The left ovary measures 2.5 x 1.5cm. Both ovaries are normal in shape, size & position.
- OTHERS** : No ascites or retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy is seen.
- IMPRESSION** :
 - No significant abnormality detected.

Interpretation:

1. TSH values are subject to circadian variation, reaching peak levels between 2 - 4 a.m. and at a minimum between 6-10 pm. The variation is of the order of 50%. Hence time of the day has influence on the measured serum TSH concentrations.
2. Alteration in concentration of Thyroid hormone binding protein can profoundly affect Total T3 and/or Total T4 levels especially in pregnancy and in patients on steroid therapy.
3. Unbound fraction (Free T4 /Free T3) of thyroid hormone is biologically active form and correlate more closely with clinical status of the patient than total T4/T3 concentration
4. Values <0.03 uIU/mL need to be clinically correlated due to presence of a rare TSH variant in some individuals.
