Because the average half life of a red blood cell is sixty days,HbA1c has been accepted as a measurnment which eflects the mean daily blood glucose concentration, better than fasting blood glucose determination, and the degree of carbohydrate imbalance over the preceding two months.

\*It may also provide a better index of control of the diabetic patient without resorting to glucose loading procedures.

\*Errneous values might be obtained from samples with abnormally elevated quantities of other Haemoglobins as a result of either their simultaneous elution with HbA1c(HbF) or differences in their glycation from that of HbA(HbS)
