Clinical Implications:

- *Values are frequently increased in persons with poorly controlled or newly diagnosed diabetes.
- *With optimal control, the HbA 1c moves toward normal levels.
- *A diabetic patient who recently comes under good control may still show higher concentrations of glycosylated hemoglobin. This level declines gradually over several months as nearly normal glycosylated *Increases in glycosylated hemoglobin occur in the following non-diabetic conditions: a. Iron-deficiency anemia b. Splenectomy
- c. Alcohol toxicity d. Lead toxicity
- *Decreases in A 1c occur in the following non-diabetic conditions: a. Hemolytic anemia b. chronic blood loss
- *Pregnancy d. chronic renal failure. Interfering Factors:
- *Presence of Hb F and H causes falsely elevated values. 2. Presence of Hb S, C, E, D, G, and Lepore (autosomal recessive mutation resulting in a hemoglobinopathy) causes falsely decreased values.

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

- 1) Patients having low T3 and T4 levels but high TSH levels suffer from primary hypothyroidism, cretinism, juvenile myxedema or autoimmune disorders.
- 2) Patients having high T3 and T4 levels but low TSH levels suffer from Grave's disease, toxic adenoma or sub-acute thyroiditis.
- 3) Patients having either low or normal T3 and T4 levels but low TSH values suffer from iodine deficiency or secondary hypothyroidism.
- **4)** Patients having high T3 and T4 levels but normal TSH levels may suffer from toxic multinodular goiter. This condition is mostly a symptomatic and may cause transient hyperthyroidism but no persistent symptoms.
- 5) Patients with high or normal T3 and T4 levels and low or normal TSH levels suffer either from T3 toxicosis or T4 toxicosis respectively.
- **6)** In patients with non thyroidal illness abnormal test results are not necessarily indicative of thyroidism but may be due to adaptation to the catabolic state and may revert to normal when the patient recovers.
- 7) There are many drugs for eg. Glucocorticoids, Dopamine, Lithium, Iodides, Oral radiographic dyes, etc. which may affect the thyroid function tests.
- **8**) Generally when total T3 and total T4 results are indecisive then Free T3 and Free T4 tests are recommended for further confirmation along with TSH levels.

ULTRASOUND WHOLE ABDOMEN (UPPER & LOWER) *

The liver is normal in size (14.8 cm), shape and **shows diffuse increase in the liver parenchymal echogenecity suggestive of grade I fatty changes**. No focal lesion is seen. No intra hepatic biliary radicle dilation seen.

Gall bladder is well distended and is normal.

Portal vein and CBD are not dilated.

Pancreas is normal in size, shape and echogenecity.

Spleen is normal in size (10.6 cm), shape and echogenecity.

Right kidney is normal in size, shape and echogenecity. No focal lesion or calculus seen. Right pelvicalyceal system is not dilated.

Right kidney measures: 9.7 x 3.3 cm

Left kidney is normal in size, shape and echogenecity. No focal lesion or calculus seen. Left pelvicalyceal system is not dilated.

Left kidney measures: 11.0 x 4.9 cm

Urinary bladder is normal in shape, outline and distension. Lumen is anechoic and no wall thickening seen. The prostate is normal in size (vol- 12 cc), shape and echopattern.

No free fluid is seen in the abdomen/pelvis.

High Resolution USG - No abnormal bowel wall thickening or bowel loop dilatation is seen. Ileocecal junction and cecum is seen normally. Appendix is not visualized. No mesenteric lymphadenopathy is seen.

IMPRESSION :-- Hepatic steatosis grade I.
