ULTRASOUND OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Liver is enlarged; it measure 17.7cms & shows grade II-III fatty infiltration. No focal lesion seen. The hepatic and portal veins are normal. There is no intrahepatic biliary dilatation.

Gall bladder is well distended and has echo free contents. There is no wall hypertrophy. The C.B.D is normal caliber.

The pancreas, spleen and the para-aortic region are normal.

Right kidney shows 5mm calculus at lower pole. No hydronephrosis & hydroureter

Both kidneys are normal in size and echotexture. There is no evidence of hydronephrosis or calculus disease in left kidney. Cortico-medulary differentiation is maintained.

Urinary Bladder is well distended and has smooth margins. No calculus seen.

Prostate is normal in size & echotexture.

There is no ascites or obvious adenopathy.

Bowel pattern is unremarkable.

IMPRESSION:-

- Mild hepatomegaly with grade II-III fatty infiltration.
- Small right renal calculus.
