Microscopic Description:

Pap stained smears show intermediate and superficial squamous epithelial cells in small groups and singly.

Few of these cells show mild increase in nuclear size & some cells are colonised by bacterial colonies. Few small group of endocervical cells with some cells showing cytoplasmic vacuoles seen. Fair number of polymorphs & few budding yeast cells are seen scattered in the background. No trichomonas vaginalis or candida seen. No atypical cells or koilocytes seen.

Conclusion Mild Inflammation : Candidiasis.; negative for intra-epithelial lesion or malignancy.
