### USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

- LIVER** : Liver is normal in size & shape. It appears bright in echotexture. No obvious focal lesion is seen. IHBR are not dilated.
- GALL BLADDER** : GB is well distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen. The wall thickness is normal.
- CBD** : CBD is normal in course & caliber.
- PV** : PV is normal in course & caliber.
- PANCREAS** : Pancreas is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Peripancreatic soft tissues appear normal. MPD is not dilated.
- SPLEEN** : Spleen is normal in shape, size & echotexture. It measures 9.8cm in size.
- KIDNEYS** : The right kidney measures 10.2 x 4.6cm. The left kidney measures 10.5 x 4.7cm. Both kidneys are normal in shape, size & position. The pelvicalyceal system is normal. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. A simple cyst measuring 4.2 x 4.2cm is seen at the mid pole of right kidney.
- URINARY BLADDER** : Urinary bladder is well distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen. The wall thickness is normal.
- PROSTATE** : Prostate is normal in size, shape & echotexture. It measures 3.8 x 2.7 x 2.8cm in size (volume – 14.9gram).
- OTHERS** : No ascites or retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy is seen.

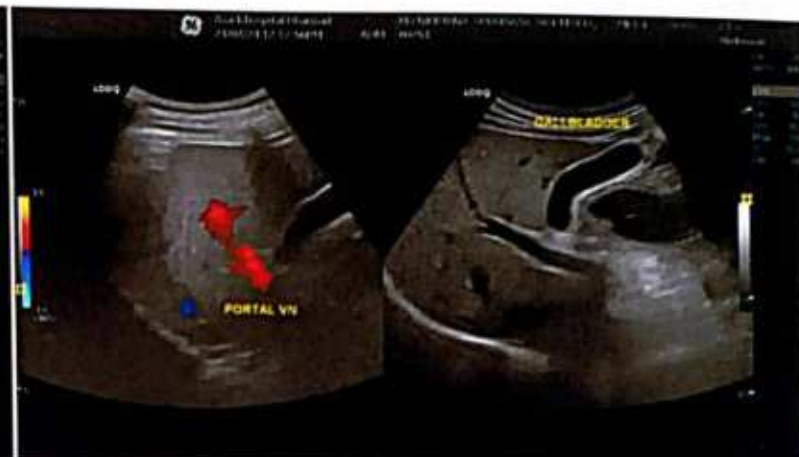
