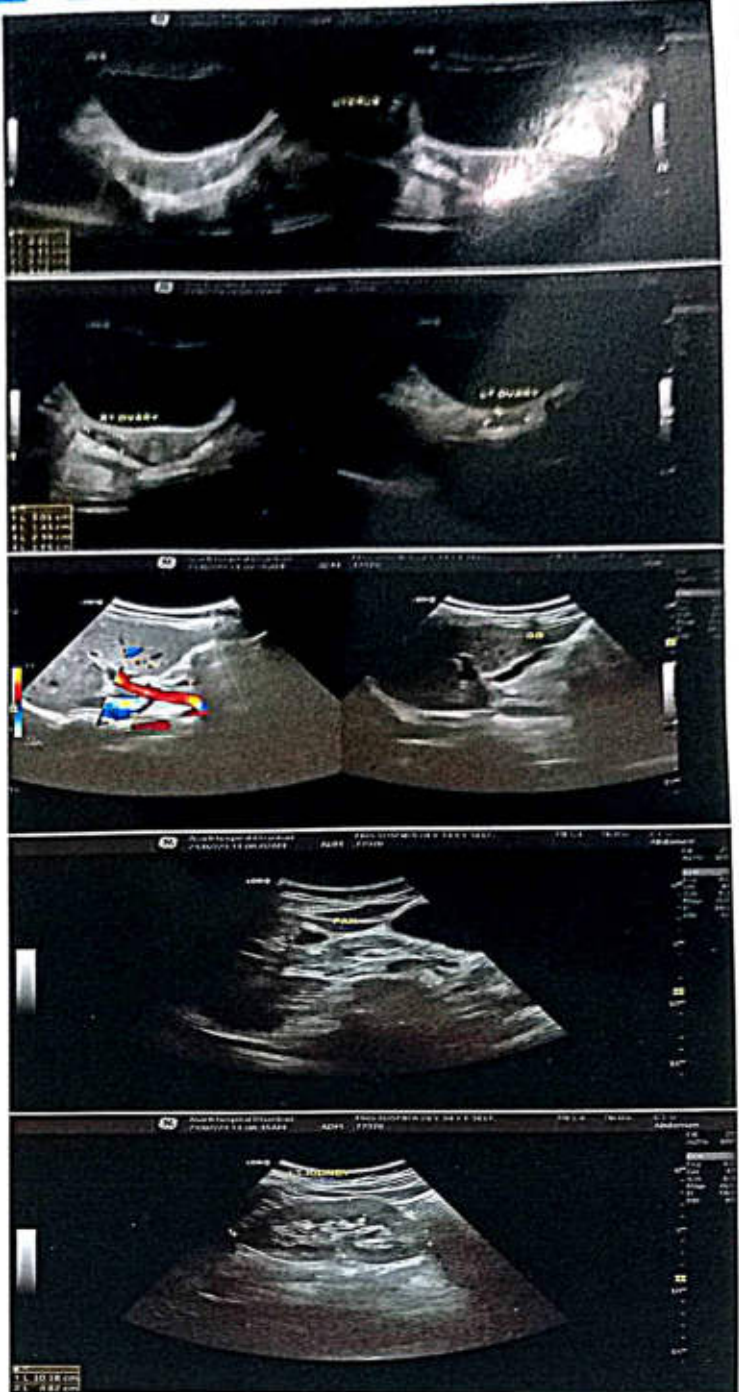
USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

- LIVER** : Liver is normal in size, shape & echotexture. No obvious focal lesion is seen. IHBR are not dilated.
- GALL BLADDER** : GB is partially distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen.
- CBD** : CBD is normal in course & caliber.
- PV** : PV is normal in course & caliber.
- PANCREAS** : Pancreas is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Peripancreatic soft tissues appear normal. MPD is not dilated.
- SPLEEN** : Spleen is normal in shape, size & echotexture. It measures 9cm in size.
- KIDNEYS** : The right kidney measures 9.9 x 3.1cm. The left kidney measures 10.1 x 4.8cm. Both kidneys are normal in shape, size & position. The pelvicalyceal system is normal. Corticomedullary differentiation is maintained. No focal lesion is seen.
- URINARY BLADDER** : Urinary bladder is well distended. Multiple internal echoes are seen in the lumen. The wall thickness is normal.
- UTERUS** : Uterus is normal in size, shape & echotexture. It measures 7.8 x 3.5 x 4.4cm. Endometrium is central and measures 6.1mm.
- OVARIES** : The right ovary measures 3 x 1.4cm. The left ovary measures 2.3 x 1.5cm. Both ovaries are normal in shape, size & position.
- OTHERS** : No ascites or retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy is seen.
- IMPRESSION** :
 - Multiple internal echoes in the urinary bladder. Correlate with urine examination to rule out cystitis.
