2014 Bethesda system for reporting cervical cytology


Specimen adequacy:
Satisfactory

Microscopy:
The smears show superficial squamous and intermediate squamous epithelial cells with collection of chronic inflammatory cells.
Endocervical / transformation zone component is seen.

Interpretation / result:
Smears are suggestive of "**Negative for intra-epithelial lesion or malignancy - NILM**" with reactive cellular changes associated with inflammation.

Please note:- Papanicolaou smear study is a screening procedure for cervical cancer with inherent false negative results , hence should be interpreted with caution.
