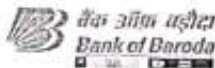

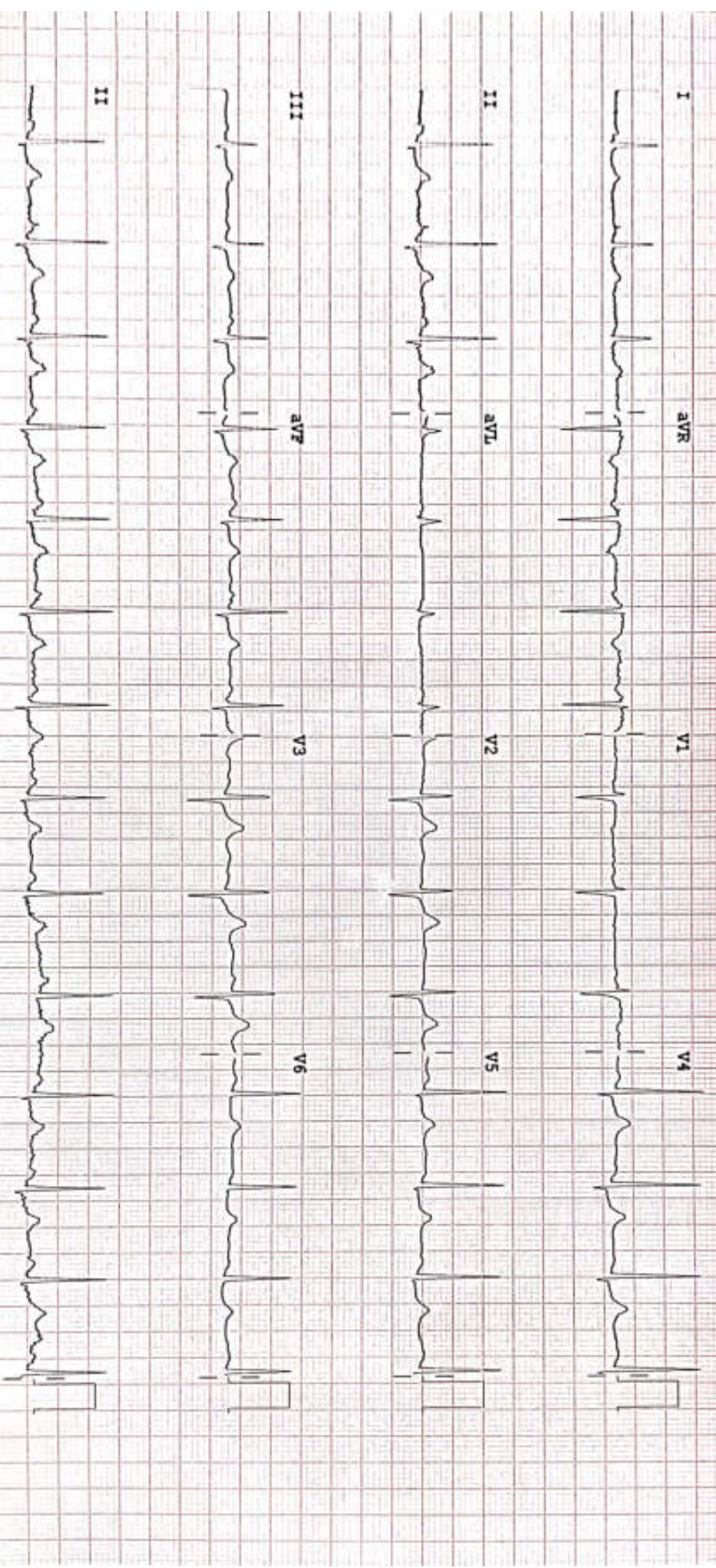

USG WHOLE ABDOMEN

- LIVER** : Liver is normal in size, shape & echotexture. No obvious focal lesion is seen. IHBR are not dilated.
- GALL BLADDER** : GB is well distended. No obvious calculus or mass lesion is seen. The wall thickness is normal.
- CBD** : CBD is normal in course & caliber.

- URINARY BLADDER** : Urinary bladder is well distended. Multiple internal echoes are seen in the lumen. The wall thickness is normal.
- UTERUS** : Uterus is normal in size, shape & echotexture. It measures 7.6 x 2.8 x 4cm. Endometrium is central and measures 8mm.
- OVARIES** : The right ovary measures 2.1 x 1.1cm. The left ovary measures 2.2 x 1.2cm. Both ovaries are normal in shape, size & position.

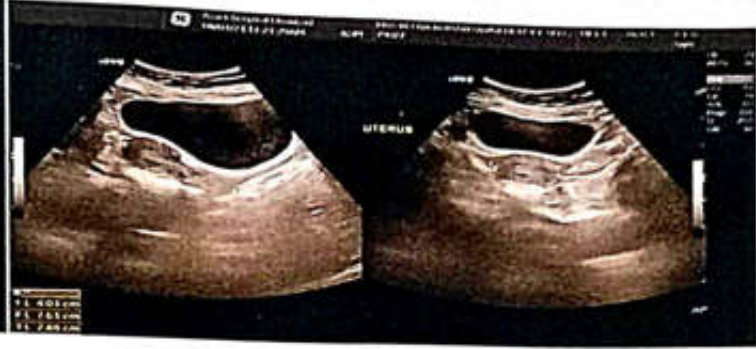

Technique

Ultrasonography of both breasts was done using a high frequency linear transducer.

Observation

Bilateral breasts show mixed fatty and fibroglandular parenchyma.

There is no evidence of any solid mass or cystic lesion in both breasts.

Bilateral nipples and retroareolar region appear unremarkable.

No significant axillary lymph nodes are seen.

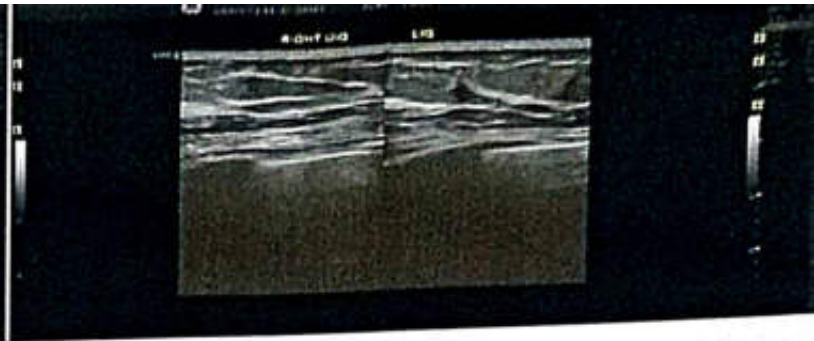
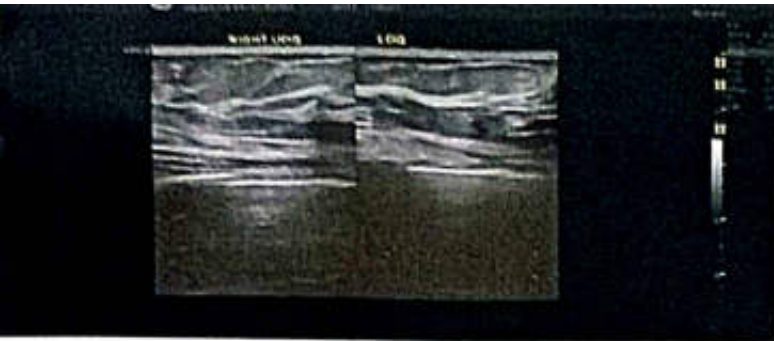
